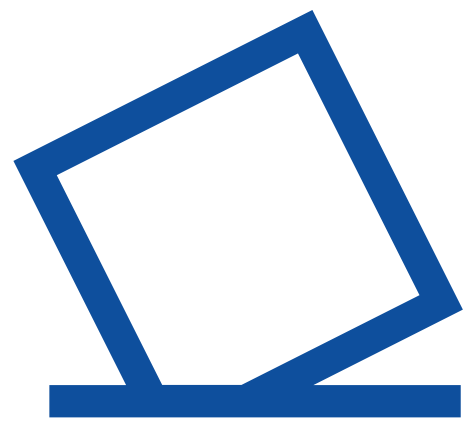

What are the rules for voting?

- You are at least 16 years old.
- You are a citizen of an EU country.
- You have been living in Germany for at least 3 months.
- If you are not a German citizen, you must register to vote by May 19, 2024 (registration in the electoral roll).
- You can only vote once.

What are the European elections?

- In the European elections, you elect the members of the European Parliament.
- These members then represent EU citizens in the Parliament of the European Union (EU).
- The election takes place in all 27 EU countries.

How do I cast my vote?

- The voter's notification will be sent to your postal address between April 28 and May 19.
- The location of the polling station is indicated on your personal voter's notification (or how you can apply for postal voting).
- You go there on June 9th between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. and bring with you: your ID or passport and your voter's notification.
- You receive your ballot paper, go (alone) into the voting booth, and make a cross in front of the list of candidates of a political party or association of your choice.
- You fold the paper and throw it into the ballot box.
- You don't have to tell anyone where you put your cross.

Why is voting important?

- The members of the European Parliament make decisions that are important for your everyday life, for example: work, health, and the environment.
- Your voice is important.
- You choose and decide.
